Program Director Report - GK Russ Woodford

- Used Coats Update: Collected 200 used coats and 70 winter hats. People still continuing to drop-off and box is still out.
- **Button Sales**: Christmas Begins with Christ Bought 300; sold out completely. Gross \$520 dollars; \$210 Cost of merchandise; will donate money to Loreto House.
- Coats for Kids: Past weekend was first collection effort; raised \$1,800. \$1,000 was one individual. Doing it again this weekend. Will also take donations during this meeting.
- **Brisket tacos**: Taking December off due to holidays. Shifting to 2-3 cooking teams once we get started again.
- **Fish Fry**: Met with Father during monthly meeting. Father wants people coming for stations. We may do a 5:30-6:30 pick-up time with stations going on before or after. We will target a "togo" style again.
- Gaga Pit: B. Story SMdP School Gaga Pit was completed 12/10/21.
 - Six Knights (Ruben Diaz, Nick Cumberland, Brandon Story, Russ Woodford, Carlos Olivares and Dave Griffin) and three school dads (John Ross, Jarad Boase, Charles Odegard) participated.
 - o It was a solid all day activity, but school kids have already been using it.
 - Article submitted to North Texas Catholic, Texas Knights and National KofC magazine.
 - Budget was \$450 / Spent \$848, but returned \$211 worth of material and screws. Also received a check from a donor for \$100.
 - Final balance, \$537, or \$87.99 over budget.
 - Still need to apply stain / sealant in a couple of weeks to weatherize it.
 - Thanks to Ruben Diaz for being the foreman.
 - o Ed Flanagan: School is very appreciative.
- Bingo Night: Nathan Bernard Planning for next event underway. Talk to Nathan Bernard if interested.
